"As you may already know CAV was started in 1997. Since then, 100% of our designated contributions have gone to the widows, orphans and the poorest of the poor. CAV currently has 3 programs to help eradicate poverty:

- ❖ Micro-finance loans are serving 3000 clients and feeding 15,800 children.
- ❖ CAV High School which was opened in 2008 is educating 64 students who are orphans of ethnic wars and genocide and are victims of HIV/AIDS.
- ❖ Reconciliation Conferences, conducted every year since 1997, have helped promote peace and national unity in Rwanda, Burundi and DR Congo.
- ❖ "However, in order for us to continue to do this work we also have overhead expenses to pay for as do all ministries like CAV. We do our best to keep these at a minimum so that as much money can go to the poorest of the poor as possible. Today our general fund is all but used up so we are seeking to raise **\$10,000.00** to keep us going into the next year. 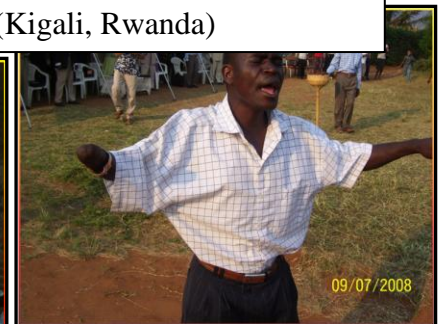
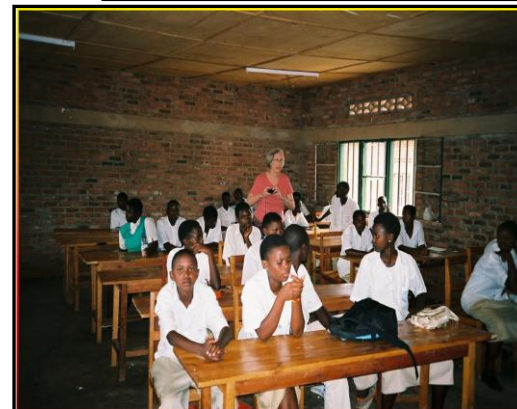
